Speaker Biographies

Jo-Anne Matear

Special Advisor to the Executive on Sustainable Finance and Emerging Regulatory Issues at the Ontario Securities Commission

As a member of the Ontario Securities Commission's Senior Management Team, Jo-Anne is the Special Advisor to the Executive on Sustainable Finance and Emerging Regulatory Issues. She has led several significant policy initiatives, including those focused on environmental, social and governance issues. For example, she co-leads the Canadian Securities Administrators' (CSA) initiatives regarding climate-related disclosures and diversity on corporate boards and in executive roles.

Jo-Anne was previously a Manager in the Corporate Finance Branch, where she led a team of lawyers, accountants and geologists in the oversight of public companies, including the review of prospectuses, continuous disclosure documents and applications for exemptive relief.

Prior to joining the Commission, Jo-Anne practised corporate and securities law in Toronto, Ontario and London, England. Jo-Anne received her Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) from Queen's University and her Bachelor of Laws from the University of Toronto.

Yasser Mounsi

Head of Corporate Finance and Financial Disclosure Department Moroccan Capital Market Authority (AMMC); Co-Chair of the SBFN Measurement Working Group

Yasser supervises the approval of issuer prospectuses as well as their compliance with ongoing information obligations. He is also actively involved in many regulatory projects and working groups aimed at market development, such as sustainable finance, where he had a significant contribution in drafting the Moroccan framework. Yasser joined the AMMC in 2008 where he held several positions before being appointed as Head of Corporate Finance and Financial Disclosure. Prior to joining the AMMC, he was responsible for internal auditing at a multinational company. Yasser serves as

the Chair of the Sustainability Working Group of the IOSCO AMERC committee.

Yasser holds a master's degree in corporate finance from Al Akhawayn University in Ifrane (Morocco).

Maia Godemer

Sustainable Finance Associate at BloombergNEF

Maia is a senior associate in the sustainable finance team for BloombergNEF (BNEF), which is a strategic research provider covering global commodity markets and the disruptive technologies driving the transition to a low-carbon economy. Maia particularly focuses on sustainable debt, transition finance and sustainable finance regulations. Maia was part of the EU Platform on Sustainable Finance as support of Bloomberg member Nadia Humphreys (also known as "Sherpa role") up until October 2022. Maia holds a Bachelor in Philosophy from Université Pierre Mendès France, as well as an MSc. in Management and an MSc. in Finance from Grenoble Ecole de Management.

Stavros Gadinis

Professor of Law at Berkeley Law

Professor Gadinis' research examines questions in corporate law and financial regulation, both domestic and international. He is particularly interested in the interplay between companies and regulators, exploring the institutional framework for law enforcement, compliance, and risk management. In the last few years, he has focused on sustainability and social issues as an attempt to expand the scope of corporate governance. In *Corporate Law and Social Risk (co-authored with Amelia Miazad) (2020 Vanderbilt Law Review)*, the focus is on stakeholder outreach as a governance system seeking to identify and address social risks for the business. In a follow-up article, *A Test of Stakeholder Capitalism (co-authored with Amelia Miazad)* they explore how corporations relied on feedback from stakeholders to address the implications of the Covid pandemic. His article *The Hidden Power of Compliance (co-authored with Amelia Miazad) (2019 Minnesota Law Review)* explores how extensive internal reporting within companies impacts the liability of board members.

In *Collaborative Gatekeepers (co-authored with Colby Mangels) (2016 Washington & Lee Law Review)* he explores anti-money laundering law as a model of pro-active misconduct reporting. Gadinis' work has also traced the spread of financial standards around the world, showing how private,

regulator, or government supports leads to distinct results (*Three Pathways to Global Standards, 2015 American Journal of International Law*). Gadinis has

argued that systemic risk reforms introduced after the 2008 financial crisis has resulted in increasing the role of political appointees over independent regulators in the oversight of the financial system (*2012 California Law Review*).

Before entering into academia, Gadinis practiced corporate law for four years in Europe. Gadinis completed his S.J.D. at Harvard in May 2010. He also holds an LL.M. degree from the University of Cambridge (UK), and a law degree from Aristotle University, Greece.

Véronique Ormezzano

Founder and Chairperson, VYGE Consulting

Véronique is an independent expert in financial regulation, financial policy, and sustainable finance, who collaborates with think tanks and industry associations in France, Europe, and internationally to promote effective regulation, sound risk management, efficient markets, ambitious ESG policies and financial stability. She is also a member of the EBA Banking Stakeholder Group.

In January 2023, Véronique retired from BNP Paribas, where she was most recently responsible for the definition of BNP Paribas' responses to new regulations, with a focus on prudential, capital markets and ESG regulations. She was also in charge of the group's relationships with regulatory authorities, industry associations, and peers, as relates to financial regulation and policies.

Claudia Castro

Director of Fixed Income Research at Invesco

Claudia Castro is a Director of Fixed Income Research for the Invesco Fixed Income team.

Ms. Castro joined Invesco when the firm combined with OppenheimerFunds in 2019. She joined OppenheimerFunds in 2004 and has covered emerging markets since 2000, with a special focus on the Americas and Africa. In addition to her work on emerging market sovereigns, Ms. Castro leads the firm's development of its ESG sovereign infrastructure solution. It combines Invesco's Fixed Income proprietary ESG scores with specialist insight to build

out qualitative assessments integrated into sovereign bond investing. Ms. Castro started her career in the global securities industry at Morgan Stanley,

serving in the global economics group. She held academic and research positions at various institutions, including the Belgium University of Louvain, the Central Bank of Spain, the International Monetary Fund, and the World Bank. Over the course of her tenures as an economist, political scientist, and financial market practitioner, she has covered a range of advanced, emerging, and frontier markets, focusing on political risk, policymaking, and capital markets. Earlier in her training career, she worked on various economic projects in Brazil, Switzerland, and Italy, at Companhia Vale do Rio Doce, Esso Brasil SA, International Trade Centre Unctad/GATT, and Pirelli Coordinamento Pneumatici.

Ms. Castro earned a BA degree in economics from Universidade do Estado do Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, a master's in political science from the University of Pennsylvania, and a master's and PhD in economics from Columbia University, where her main area of research was international finance.

Sudhir Roc-Sennett

Executive Director and Head of Thought Leadership & ESG at Vontobel Asset Management

Sudhir Roc-Sennett joined Vontobel Asset Management in August 2010. He leads the ESG, engagement, and proxy voting efforts for firm's Quality Growth Boutique. He also manages the boutique's thought leadership, bringing a more spontaneous conversation to clients and stakeholders on a broad range of subjects, including insights into the less seen workings of companies held.

Prior to joining Vontobel Asset Management, from 2007 to 2010, he was Director of European Cash Equity Sales and Head of Global Macro Sales at Société Générale. From 2005 to 2007, he worked as a Managing Director at Middlebury Equity Partners, a fund invested in private equity and mezzanine debt. From 2001 to 2005, he was President and Chief Executive Officer of Pompous Pot Foods. From 1995 to 2001, he was a Senior Equity Analyst and Head of Equity Research of the Americas at BNP Paribas, New York, and from 1992 to 1995, an Equity Analyst at Casa de Bolsa Interacciones in Mexico City. Prior to that, Sudhir Roc-Sennett began his financial career in 1989.

He received a Master of Science in Investment Analysis from the University of Stirling in the United Kingdom. He also is an associate of the CFA Society of the United Kingdom.

Viet-Linh Nguyen

Head of the Strategy & Sustainable Finance Unit in the Department of Regulation Policy & International Affairs at the Autorité des Marchés Financiers

Viet-Linh Nguyen is Head of Strategy and Sustainable Finance and Secretary to the Executive Committee of the French Market Authority (Autorité des Marchés Financiers) since March 2022. His unit is part of the Regulatory Policy and International Affairs Directorate.

He is involved in international and European negotiations relating to sustainable finance (e.g. IOSCO Sustainable Finance Task Force, ESMA Coordination Network on Sustainability). His transversal team is in charge of analyzing all ESG issues in a holistic manner, both regulation, market initiatives and emerging trends, and to foster stakeholders' engagement; in particular through the AMF Climate and Sustainable Finance Committee, that gathers more than 20 ESG actors (financial market participants, NGO, academics, public bodies).

He joined the AMF in 2018 as Deputy Director of the European and International Affairs Division. Prior to that, M. Nguyen held various positions at Banque de France, the French Prudential Authority Authority (ACPR) and the French Treasury.

Viet-Linh Nguyen holds a Master's degree from Sciences Po Paris and is an alumnus of HEC and Trinity College Dublin. He was a lecturer at Sciences Po Paris, and is currently a lecturer at the École des Hautes Études Internationales et Politiques on financial regulation and international negotiations.

Louisa Chender

Technical Specialist in ESG Policy and Advisory at the Financial Conduct Authority of the United Kingdom

Louisa is a Technical Specialist in the FCA's ESG Policy and Advisory team where she focuses on sustainability-related disclosures. She is currently leading on the Sustainability Disclosure Requirements and investment labels, having previously led on climate-related disclosure rules for asset managers and FCA-regulated asset owners. She also supports the IOSCO Sustainable Finance Taskforce's work on corporate reporting, particularly on assurance of sustainability-related disclosures.

Audit & Assurance Partner at Deloitte Brazil

Mr. Oliari is an partner of audit and assurance at Deloitte Brazil in São Paulo office. He has over 20 years of experience in finance, accounting and auditing and 17 years at Deloitte, serving several large public and private companies in various business segments.
